

Ground Rules:

- We will refuse to sell alcohol to Muslims or minors below 21 years old.
- All purchased Starter Pack, Advanced Pack, tokens, food and beverages cannot be refunded.
- Please note that we will not refund or exchange damaged or lost of your redeemed items.
- Excess tokens will not be exchanged for cash.
- Refunds cannot be made for cancellations after the event ends.
- Only original Dajin Sip Fest sake glasses can be used during the event period.
- All sake will only be poured into the Dajin Sip Fest sake glasses that are included in the Starter Pack and Advanced Pack.
- Please dispose of your tableware in the garbage bins provided at the venue.
- Please be careful in managing your bags and valuables, we are not responsible for any loss or damage to your personal belongings.
- All menus and event schedules are subject to change without notice due to any circumstances.
- Respect the venue and its rules. Avoid any damage to property after drinking.
- No smoking and vaping inside the event area. Please proceed to the designated specific smoking areas to smoke and please dispose of cigarette butts properly.
- If you plan to drink, arrange for a designated driver or alternative transportation home. Never drink and drive.
- No Outside alcohol and food are allowed at the event.
- Treat all attendees, organizers, and staff with respect and courtesy. Maintain a positive and friendly demeanour throughout the event.
- Dispose of your rubbish properly in designated areas when you're done with a tasting or eating. Don't leave used cutleries lying around.
- Be courteous to fellow attendees. Keep conversations at a reasonable volume and avoid disturbing others who are enjoying their sake.
- If you plan to share your experience on social media, be mindful of others' privacy and the event's policies regarding photography and posting.
- Do not bring any harmful items, including weapons, illegal drugs, or anything that can pose a danger to yourself and others.
- Please refrain from bringing any pets into the event.

- Familiarize yourself with the event's emergency procedures and locations of first aid stations. Follow all rules and regulations set by the event venue. Keep the space clean, and dispose of trash properly. Vandalism or damage to the property is not tolerated.
- Be aware of and respect local alcohol laws and regulations.
- Lastly, have fun, learn about sake, and appreciate the cultural experience of the event while ensuring your safety and that of others.
